

## Campground Rules

1. **ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK**
2. No pets of any kind except for medical reasons.
3. All building / structures on festival grounds are smoke free.
4. Propane cooking grills only. NO CHARCOAL!
5. Please use cigarette receptacles throughout the campgrounds.
6. Half Moon Sober Festival and Sugar Shack Campground ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or stolen items or personal injury.
7. Camping is allowed in designated areas only.
8. No bicycle riding after dusk and helmets are required BY ALL! Bicycles will be confiscated for duration of festival or until departure from festival grounds.
9. All vehicles must be parked in our on site parking lot after unloading. Please be courteous!
10. All fires are to be in established pits only.

**Event Hours:** Festival grounds are open from 6 a.m. Friday to noon on Monday. NO early admittance!

**Day / Evening Tickets:** The Day Ticket Lot opens 6:00 a.m. on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday and MUST be vacated by 1:00 a.m. each night. Day ticket holders are not permitted to camp on site or stay overnight. Parking is free.

**Tent Camping:** Your weekend pass entitles you to camp on site for the entire weekend. Parking is free. There are NO CABINS.

**RV Camping:** RVs are welcome. Parking for RVs is on a first come, first serve basis in the designated areas. .

### FOR YOUR COMFORT:

**Provisions:** You should bring warm clothes, towels, extra shoes, a lawn chair, a blanket, rain gear, bug spray, sunscreen, and a flashlight with extra batteries. Campers should also provide their own tents, sleeping gear, and toiletries. Small items may be available for sale at the local store. Please check your equipment before you leave.

*US-3 North/Everett TNPk N – about 33 miles it turns into I-93 53.8 miles Take RT-49 E exit 28- toward Campton / Waterville Valley 0.2 miles, turn slight right onto NH 49 / Waterville Rd 1.0 miles turn left onto NH-175 / Livermore Road 3.8 miles end at 2010 NH Route 175, Thornton, NH.*

*From Points East:*

Route 95, Rt. 495, RT 101, or RT 4 (depending on your starting point) to I-93 53.8 miles (same as above)

*From Points West:*

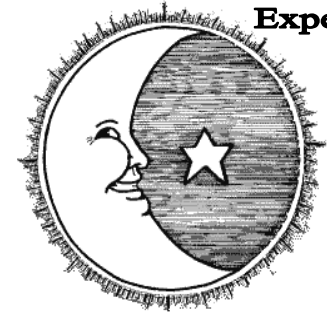
Take Route 90, RT 2, RT 101, RT 0, or RT 89 (depending on your starting point) to I-93 N 53.8 miles, (same as above)

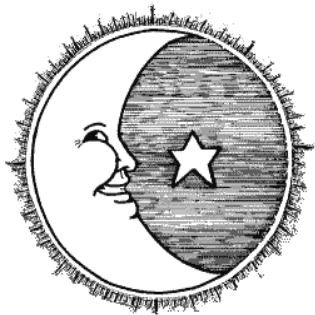
