

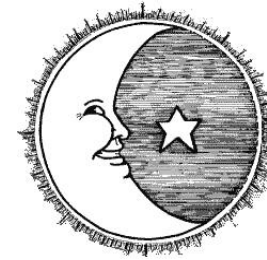
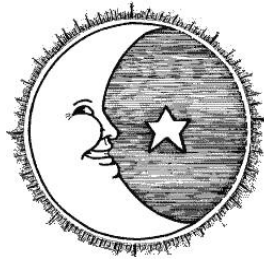
Campground Rules

1. **ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK**
2. **NO PETS** of any kind except for Service Animals with the proper paper work.
3. All building / structures on festival grounds are smoke free.
4. Propane cooking grills only. **NO CHARCOAL!**
5. Please use cigarette receptacles throughout the campgrounds.
6. Half Moon Sober Festival and 4-H Youth Center **ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE** for lost or stolen items or personal injury.
7. Camping is allowed in designated areas only.
8. No bicycle riding after dusk and helmets are required BY ALL! Bicycles will be confiscated for duration of festival or until departure from festival grounds.
9. All day pass vehicles must be parked in our on-site parking lot. Please be courteous.
10. All fires are to be in **suitable above ground apparatus.**
11. **No outside firewood** as per State Regulation.
12. No **fireworks!**
13. No tree or shrub may be cut, dug up or removed.

Tent Camping: Your weekend pass entitles you to: Camp on site for the entire weekend. Parking is free. There are NO CABINS.

RV Camping: RVs are welcome. Parking for RVs is on a first come, first serve basis in the designated areas. There is a limited number of RV sites with power and water, separate charge for hookups. (Reserve early)

FOR YOUR COMFORT: You should bring warm clothes, towels, extra shoes, a lawn chair, a blanket, rain gear, bug spray, sunscreen, and a flashlight with extra batteries. Campers should also provide their own tents, sleeping gear, and toiletries. Small items may be available for sale at the local store. Please check your equipment before you leave.

Event Hours: Festival grounds are open from 6 a.m. Friday to noon on Monday. NO early admittance!

Day / Evening Tickets: The Day Ticket Lot opens 6:00 a.m. on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday and MUST be vacated by 12:00 midnight each night. Day ticket holders are not permitted to camp on site or stay overnight. Parking is free.

Driving Directions:

From Points, East:

US-3 North/Everett TNPK N to **Rt.101W** on to **Rt.114N** in to Goffstown turn left on to **Rt.13S** Pleasant St., follow **Rt.13S** along the river, **Hilldale Ln** is on the **right** (before town center). Please follow the signs to the Main Gate.

From Points, West:

US 91 to **Rt.9E** on to **Rt.101E** to **Rt. 13N** through New Boston center onto River Road (still Rt. 13N). Continue another 0.6 mile and turn left on to **Hilldale Ln**. Please follow the signs to the Main Gate.

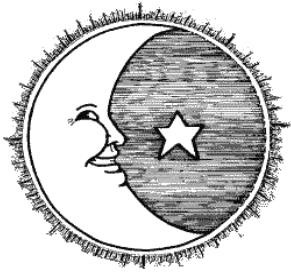
